


## Mean Rainfall for 1-28 February 2023

## **Mauritius**

Dry conditions prevailed over the island in February 2023, and it turned out to be the fourth driest February since the last 30 years. The island recorded about 156 mm of rainfall, which represents 48 % of the long-term mean. Rainfall was deficient almost over the whole island, especially in the region of Sans Souci, Union Park, Bois Cheri and Grande Providence where it was by 230-360 mm.




**Observed Rainfall (mm)**
