## Mauritius

Slightly above normal rainfall was recorded in March 2023, amounting to 335 mm which represents $114 \%$ of the long-term mean. Rainfall was in excess in the region of Medine, Ferret, Beau Champs and Tamarin by $130-185 \mathrm{~mm}$. However, locally in the region of Union Park, Britannia and Bel Etang, rainfall was deficient by $25-80 \mathrm{~mm}$.
