## Mauritius

Slightly below normal rainfall was recorded in April 2023, amounting to 178 mm which represents $86 \%$ of the long-term mean. Rainfall was in deficient in the region of Sans Souci, Union Park and Grande Providence by 190-270 mm. However, locally in the region of Vacoas, Quatre Bornes and Medine, rainfall was excess by 140175 mm .
